FUN FACTS

DID YOU KNOW?

Formal planning for the Senior Center started in June of 1995 and after 2 years of hard work and dedication by many people, we opened our doors on September 2, 1997!

The first Board of Trustees were elected on the First Annual meeting on May 16, 1997. They were as follows: President, James P. Humphrey; 1st Vice President, LuAnn Presser; 2nd vice President, Bill Gauntt; Secretary, Farrel Kaplan; Treasurer, Dale Locker (till November) Dick Roth appointed in January 1998 to finish the term; Trustee, Gene Dragonette; At-Large, Harry Faulkner, Kirsten Means (till July) Connie Watercutter appointed December 1997; and alternates: Janet Fischbach, George Groff, Dick Roth. City representative was Mike Morton; County Commissioner was John Laws.

The first Executive Director, Cheryl Liams was hired on August 18, 1997.


This does not take away any of your own Kroger Plus points or benefits.


